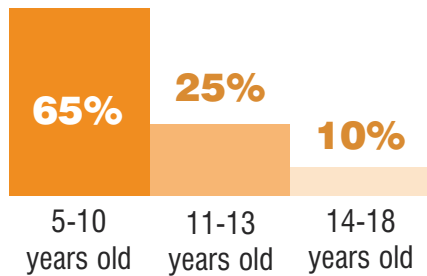
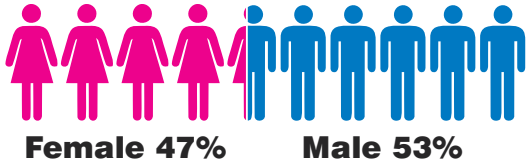

Boys & Girls Clubs of Hall County operates **8** sites that serve **1,625** members and a total of **5,605** youth annually.

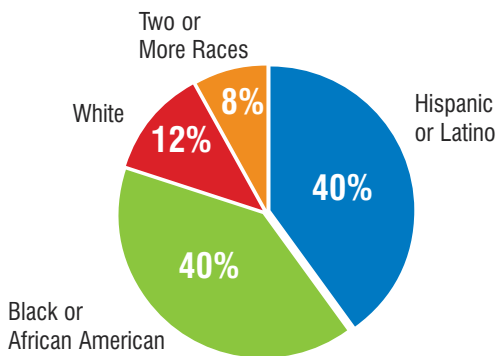

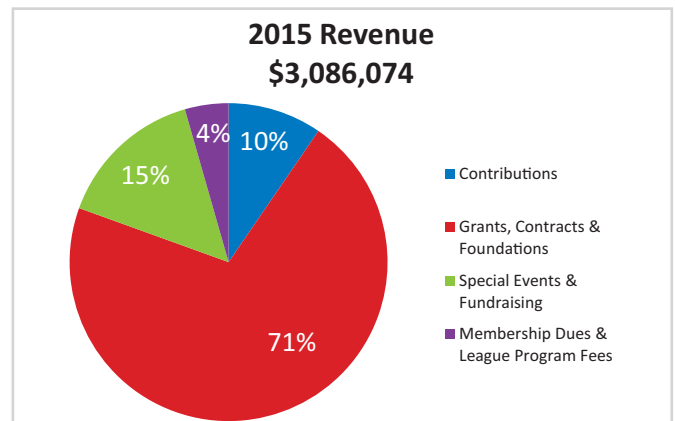
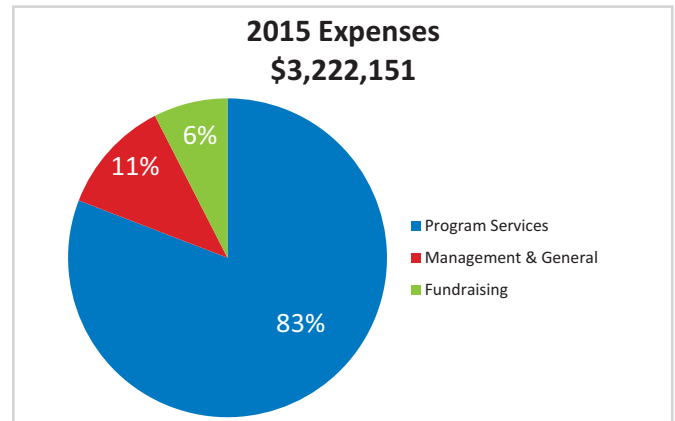
