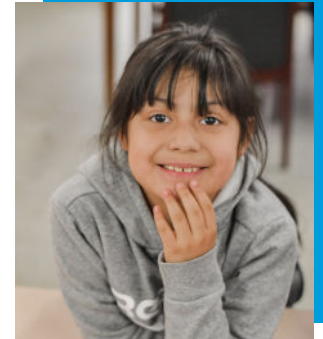

POSITIVE PLACE

While our current Positive Place Club has served us well for more than 50 years, its age, layout and space limitations are hindering us from providing kids with what they need and from expanding our programs to serve more kids.

Campaign Goals:

- Construct a new **25,000 square foot** Positive Place Club and Gymnasium to serve an **additional 250 kids**
- Provide a dedicated space for high school teens (ages 14-18) to deliver **hands-on, engaging educational opportunities** that allow them to explore a variety of career interests and have fun in the process
- Secure upgraded furnishings, technology, equipment and supplies
- Extend Club hours

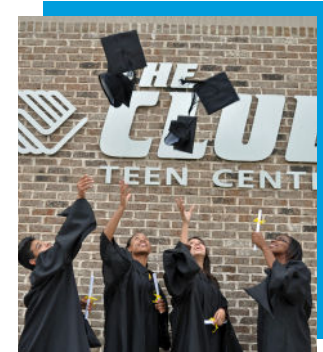


JOSEPH F. WALTERS
